Agricultural Extension in South Asia (AES) organized two workshops and published several outputs during October 2019-March 2020.

## Knowledge Management

AESA, through its website, published nine meeting notes, four good practices notes, two book reviews and one blog during this period. The AESA Facebook group currently has more than 20,100 members. We are using the Facebook group, LinkedIn group, Twitter handle and the AESA email list to promote exchange of knowledge on agricultural extension and advisory services. AESA is also handling knowledge management functions of the Asia-Pacific Islands Rural Advisory Services Network (APIRAS).



## Capacity Development

AESA co-organized a national workshop on 'Advanced Research Methodology for Social Sciences' from 6 to 11 January 2020 at ICAR Research Complex for North Eastern Hill Region (ICAR-RC-NEH), Umiam, Meghalaya. This was done in collaboration with National Institute of Agricultural Extension Management (MANAGE), ICAR-Central Tuber Crops Research Institute (ICAR-CTCRI), Centre for Research on Innovation and Science Policy (CRISP) and ICAR-RC-NEH.



## Consultative Workshop

AESA organized a consultative workshop on 'Learning Needs Assessment for Nutrition Sensitive Agriculture (NSA) in India: Integrating Nutrition Objectives into Agricultural Extension Programmes and Policies' on 3 January 2020 in Hyderabad, India, in collaboration with the Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO),



Global Forum for Rural Advisory Services (GFRAS) and CRISP. In Telangana, a learning needs assessment was undertaken to understand the learning gaps, needs and obstacles to integrate nutrition-related objectives into agricultural programmes and policies. The findings from this study were presented during the workshop.

AESA participated in the New Extensionist Learning Kit (NELK) workshop organised by the Coconut Cultivation Board (CCB), Sri Lanka, for its extension officers on 30 October 2019 at the Coconut Development Training Center, Lunuwila, Sri Lanka.
